General Information

ENTRY: Midget, Novice, and Schoolboy/girl participants **MUST** mail the **completed OFFICIAL MEDICAL & WAIVER FORMS** (available at www.themat.com) **PLUS** the tournament entry fee (\$30 for 1 style, \$50 for 2 styles, and \$60 for 3 styles) to the wrestler's State Director (see listing in flyer) by Monday, June 2nd, 2008. **ALL** entries must be processed through your state association—individual entries **WILL NOT** be accepted. Hardship petitions should be submitted to the wrestler's State Director.

Cadet participants residing in a West Region state (as listed in this flyer) should register through their state association by mailing all necessary forms to the wrestler's State Director by Monday, June 2nd, 2008. Participants residing outside of the West Region can register at the event during the specified registration times.

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: Attractive awards to the top six (6) place winners in Folkstyle, Greco-Roman and Freestyle in each weight class. A Triple-Crown Belt Buckle award will be presented to athletes who win titles in all three styles.

RULES: The current rules of FILA, with USA Wrestling modifications where applicable, will govern the event and the competition.

UNIFORMS: Red and blue singlets, or red/blue reversible singlet with under briefs are **REQUIRED**. For female athletes, a collegiate or girls singlet is required and a sleeveless sport top is to be worn under the singlet (no T-shirts). **Head-gear is required for all Midget, Novice, and Schoolboy/girl wrestlers. No two-piece uniforms allowed!**

PAIRINGS: Contestants are randomly drawn by computer. Wrestlers from the same state will be separated. The pool system, with cross-bracketing, will be employed if there are six (6) or more entrants in any given weight class.

COACHING: FLOOR PASS IS REQUIRED. Coaches floor passes will only be issued to those individuals with a current USAW Coaches Membership Card and are a minimum USAW NCEP Copper certified. Coaches Membership Cards should be obtained from your state office prior to the event. Two certified coaches maximum allowed in each competitor's corner. During a match, no coaches are allowed to videotape a match in the competitor's corner. To videotape any match at mat side, the operator must purchase a video pass, stay within the designated area for videotaping and must remain silent and not coach any athlete. Video passes will be available for purchase at the tournament for \$10.

MEDICAL INFORMATION: Athletes must be present in a **COMPETITION SINGLET** and must submit to a skin disease screening prior to weigh-in. The chief medical officer has full

authority without appeal in determining the eligibility of an athlete to compete. In the event of injury or illness, no contestant will be permitted to continue the competition without approval of the Chief Medical Officer, whose decision is final and not subject to appeal.

WEIGH-INS: An athlete competing in three styles may weigh in once for all styles. This is contingent on the athlete actively competing in the first two of three wrestling styles scheduled. An athlete competing in two styles may weigh in once for both styles. This is contingent on the athlete actively competing in the first one of two wrestling styles scheduled. **Athletes competing in one style MUST weigh in at the official weigh-in for that style. All athletes must be present at BEGINNING of weigh-ins.** Each athlete will be allowed two consecutive attempts to make weight and may not leave the weigh-in area. All wrestlers must be dressed in a **COMPETITION SINGLET** for weigh-ins and no weight allowance is given for the singlet. A wrestler may compete in the Regional Championships at a weight equal to or higher than the lowest weight class, regardless of style, in which he/she qualified at the state level.

ELIGIBILITY: All athletes and coaches must present proof of current USA Wrestling Membership Card at registration. To purchase a USA Wrestling Card, go to the www.themat.com click on "Membership," and follow the instructions. Alternatively, Membership Cards can be acquired from the State Chairperson or State Membership Director of the contestant's state of residence. Secondary sports accident insurance is provided as a benefit of membership.

KIDS REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS (Midget, Novice & Schoolboy/girl): ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST reside in a West Region state (as listed in this flyer), must have qualified in a competitive event under the sanction of USA Wrestling in the state where he/she resides, and must be certified by the state association to participate in the Kids freestyle and/or Greco-Roman regional tournament. Each state may enter a maximum of eight (8) athletes in each weight class, per style.

All Midget, Novice and Schoolboy/girl wrestlers participating in the freestyle and Greco-Roman regional tournament qualify for the ASICS Kids Freestyle & Greco-Roman National Championships in Orem, Utah; July 2—July 5, 2008.

CADET REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS: Competition is open to all Cadets, regardless of state of residence. This event **IS NOT** a qualifier for the 2008 Accelerade Cadet National Championships. For Cadet national qualifiers, contact your state office or the USA Wrestling national office.
